

cinitas What Should go in the Green Cart?

The organics recycling program collects food scraps and yard waste mixed together in your green cart. Below are a few examples of what should and should not be placed in your green organics cart:

Food Scraps

- · Fruits and vegetables including peels, pits and rinds
- Bread, pasta and other grains
- Dairy products and egg shells
- Coffee grounds and tea leaves
- Meats and bones
- Prepared foods in general

Green Waste

• Plants, leaves, branches, brush, weeds

• Grass clippings, hedge and floral trimmings

Food Soiled Paper

- Paper napkins and towels
- · Paper tea bags and coffee filters
- Paper plates

What should NOT go in the cart:

- No "compostable" plastic service-ware or compostable packaging
- No glass, metal, plastic or Styrofoam™
- No boxes or cartons of juice, soup, milk
- No plastic bags or film (including compostable)
