$\checkmark$ Buckets (metal handle OK)

$\checkmark$ Cups and plates (Styrofoam OK)

## Dirty paper

$\checkmark$ Greasy pizza boxes and paper bags
$\checkmark$ Paper coffee filters
$\checkmark$ Paper cups, plates (NO plastic or waxy coating)

$\checkmark$ Paper napkins, tissues, and paper towels

## Food scraps

$\checkmark$ All fruits and vegetables (pits and shells too)
$\checkmark$ Coffee grounds
$\checkmark$ Dairy products (NO liquids)
$\checkmark$ Eggshells and eggs
$\checkmark$ Leftovers and spoiled food
$\checkmark$ Meat (including bones)
$\checkmark$ Seafood (including shellfish)

## Plants

$\checkmark$ House plants
$\checkmark$ All plant debris including flowers, leaves, weeds, and straw
$\checkmark$ Grass clippings

$\checkmark$ Wooden chopsticks, Popsicle sticks, coffee stirrers, toothpicks
