

Multi-Family Property Recycling Guide

A Checklist for Property Owners and Managers to Implement a Recycling Program

The City of Encinitas is working together with the community to strengthen environmental resiliency and promote sustainability throughout Encinitas. The City's Zero Waste Campaign is a reminder to **Waste Less from Land to Sea**, and ensure residents of multi-family properties are recycling *regularly* and recycling *right*.

Multi-family properties play a critical role on the path to Zero Waste and the City wants to support you and your residents to reduce waste while complying with recycling legislation. Use this checklist to build a strong recycling program onsite and find confidence that you and your tenants are recycling right every time!



Get Started:

\Box Call EDCO: Get in contact with <u>EDCO</u> , the City of Encinitas' waste hauler, to determine if your bins are right sized and if your trash and recycling service can be optimized. Call (760) 436-4151.

Incorporate These Tools:
☐ Post Signage: Signs that guide tenants on how to sort their recycling and trash can be downloaded from the City of Encinitas website and posted at all disposal areas and in common spaces. Also offer these signs to tenants in an email and upon move-in to use as a reference.
□ <u>Update Lease Agreement</u> : Use the customizable recycling addendum for lease agreements found here, to encourage new residents to recycle and establish a strong recycling program.

Add Move-In/Move-Out Guidance: Avoid an overflowing dumpster or recycling cart by providing move-in/move-out recycling tips for tenants to reduce and/or properly dispose of waste.

Communicate With Tenants:
