Do you have any questions about how to properly recycle and what goes where? This is a reminder that our property recycles and that we are here to support all residents to make recycling as simple and straightforward as possible. Your participation in the onsite recycling program is highly encouraged, as it ensures our community spaces are clean and free from trash or hazardous materials. See some tips below!

Don't forget the basics: Always recycle EMPTY, DRY and LOOSE.



Some items that should NOT go in the recycling bin are:

- Face masks
- Compostable containers
- Plastic utensils
- Mixed materials (plastic lined shipping bags, disposable coffee cups, etc.)
- Plastic bags (take these to local retailers like Ralphs, with take-back programs!)

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) cannot go in the recycling or trash bin. Find details about the region's HHW facilities (located in Poway and Vista) and their drop-off programs by calling the County at 1-877-713-2784 or by visiting encinitasca.gov and searching "Household Hazardous Waste". Electronic waste, as well as batteries and lightbulbs, may be recycled at Solana Center in Encinitas via their E-Waste drop-off program.
