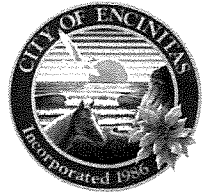

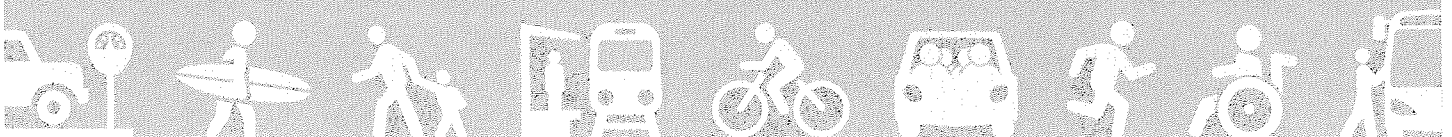

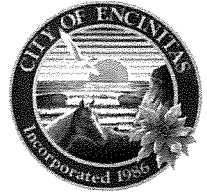

- Include weekends/weekdays for all surveys
- Ask about other transportation methods (i.e. if you ride a bike, why?)  
would you ride a bike or use car sharing - uber, etc.)
- Ask where people come from
- Why are people there (live, work, shopping, etc.)

- Expand "Why" section / - Include designated email for responses

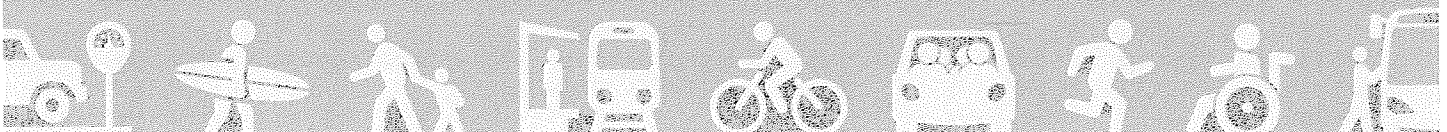

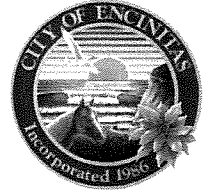

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### Parking Study - Survey Design and Methodology - Target busier nightspots

- Ask about safety perception; - Non-local residents need to be surveyed since they will drive more; - Ask what would lead them to walk/ride; - Approach walkers & ask them why & circumstances <sup>under what</sup> walk/ride

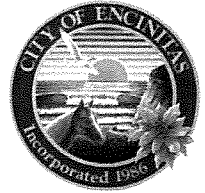

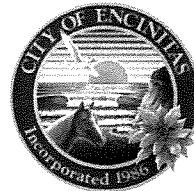

### Parking Study - Survey Design and Methodology

- ① Surveys should include questions about safety. For example add "Do you feel parking available is safe?" And ask for input.
- ② Also parking demand is seasonal. Is it too late to capture the summer parking needs?
- ③ Make sure the recommendations are ACTIONABLE. Not a list of things we could do BUT also what CAN BE DONE and exactly where. We absolutely need this.

### Pedestrian Crossing Alternatives and Wayside Horn Demonstration

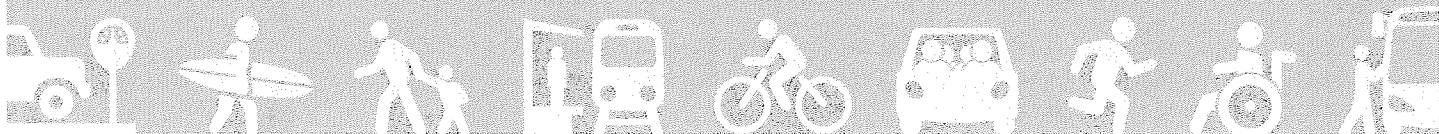
- ① Why is "trench & cover" not considered as an option? It should be - and funds should be investigated for it. Don't rule it out because of cost or environmental impacts.

- ① Has the SANDAG consultant started concepts for BIC? Can we have a presentation of this concept?

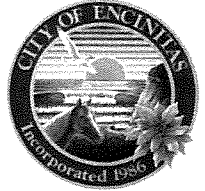
