The following criteria shall be used to determine pedestrian rail crossing locations:

- Locations Based on:
 - Proximity to Existing Crossings
 - o Proximity to Schools
 - o Proximity to Businesses
 - o Proximity to Recreational Areas
 - o Proximity to Beach Access Points,
 - Proximity to Public Transit
 - Existing User Traffic
 - o Ease of Crossing 101
 - o facilities of feeder streets
 - Existing/Planned Access to the Crossings (Safety and Multi-modal)
 - Parking
 - Availability
 - Impacts to existing
 - o Impacts to Coastal Rail Trail
 - Environmental Constraints
 - Drainage impacts
 - Right of Way Availability/Adequacy
 - Utility/Infrastructure Impacts
