Catherine S. Blakespear Council Member The City of Encinitas is in support of AB 1810 (Levine), which provides an exemption from seed law labeling of non-commercial, shared seeds. The existing law has been an impediment to seed sharing due to the threat of penalties if improperly labeled.

Your bill will be beneficial to seed libraries, which provide communities with free heirloom seeds. This will also benefit community gardens through greater exchange of seeds that produce plants that have adapted to the local environment, and through the preservation of culturally significant seed.
