WIRELESS COMMUNICATION FACILITY APPLICATION SUPPLEMENT

These items listed below must be completed and presented in their entirety at the required scheduled presubmittal "Intake" appointment with the Development Services Department. You may contact the Development Services Department at (760) 633-2710 or at planning@encinitasca.gov to schedule your appointment. If these materials are found adequate at the initial intake appointment along with the items needed as part of the standard Planning Application, including all fees and deposits, then a confirmation email will be sent to the applicant by the assigned Project Planner stating the project has been submitted. If no email is received, the project is not considered submitted.

Once the application has been submitted, the application will be reviewed in conformance with Encinitas Municipal Code requirements, State Law requirements and Federal Regulations. Once the plans have been deemed complete, then a formal decision will be prepared and signed by the Development Services Planning Manager. All decisions are subject to a 15-day appeal period once the final decision has been approved by the Development Services Department.

All equipment associated with a new or modified wireless telecommunications facility (including the addition of a new emergency generator) shall be accompanied with a noise study demonstrating compliance with Chapter 30.40 (Performance Standards).

All wireless facilities located on City owned property shall first obtain a letter of authorization from the City prior to scheduling an "intake" appointment with the Development Services Department.

APPLICATION MATERIALS REQUIRED (Section 9.70.080 of the Encinitas Municipal Code):

All applications <u>must</u> include the following materials concerning the proposed wireless communications facility with the initial intake appointment. The city retains a third-party consultant, at the applicant's expense, to review and assess technical data. All items need to be provided in a **PDF format** according to the City's Document Submission Standards (https://www.encinitasca.gov/government/departments/applications-and-information)

Planning Application (A), Application Supplement (S), Evidence of Legal Parcel (L), Disclosure Statement (D) (see Planning Application)
Major Use Permit Supplement (Required for a Major Use Permit or Major Use Permit Modification)
If the project is a qualified project under 6409(a) contained within the Middle-Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012, please provide the documentation and evidence as to why.
Emergency Generators qualifying under AB 2421 Section 65850.75 may be exempt from this process depending on their location and if they are "backing up" an existing wireless telecommunications facility. The emergency generator would, however, require a separate City Building Permit with proof of noise compliance through a noise study. Please indicate if your project qualifies under this provision.
