MEASURE L To fund general municipal expenses including law enforcement, fire, emergency medical services, street improvements and recreation, shall the City tax cannabis and hemp businesses at annual rates of between 4% to 7% of gross receipts for retail cannabis businesses, 1% to 4% for non-retail cannabis businesses, and \$2.00 to \$10.00 per canopy square foot for cultivation; expected to generate an estimated \$800,000 to \$1,400,000 annually and will be levied until repealed/modified by the voters?
