TROGLODYTIDAE WRENS		
Coastal cactus wren <i>Campylorhynchus brunneicapillus couesi</i>	CSC, MHCP, NE	Maritime succulent scrub, coastal sage scrub with <i>Opuntia</i> thickets. Rare localized resident.
SYLVIIDAE GNATCATCHERS		
Coastal California gnatcatcher <i>Polioptila californica californica</i>	FT, CSC, MHCP	Coastal sage scrub, maritime succulent scrub. Resident.
ACCIPITRIDAE HAWKS, KITES, & EAGLES		
Cooper's hawk (nesting) <i>Accipiter cooperii</i>	CSC, MHCP	Mature forest, open woodlands, wood edges, river groves. Parks and residential areas. Migrant and winter visitor.
EMBERIZIDAE EMBERIZIDS		
Belding's savannah sparrow <i>Passerculus sandwichensis beldingi</i>	SE, MHCP	Salt marshes, lagoons dominated by <i>Salicornia</i> . Resident.
VIREONIDAE VIREOS		
Least Bell's vireo (nesting) <i>Vireo bellii pusillus</i>	FE, SE, MHCP	Willow riparian woodlands. Summer resident.

PHYLLOSTOMIDAE NEW WORLD LEAF-NOSED BATS		
Mexican long-tongued bat <i>Choeronycteris mexicana</i>	CSC	Sightings in San Diego County very rare. Migratory.
MOLOSSIDAE FREE-TAILED BATS		
Pocketed free-tailed bat <i>Nyctinomops femorosaccus</i>	CSC	Normally roost in crevice in rocks, slopes, cliffs. Lower elevations in San Diego and Imperial Counties. Colonial. Leave roosts well after dark.

HETEROMYIDAE POCKET MICE & KANGAROO RATS		
Northwestern San Diego pocket mouse <i>Chaetodipus fallax fallax</i>	CSC, MHCP, NE	San Diego County west of mountains in sparse, disturbed coastal sage scrub or grasslands with sandy soils.
Pacific pocket mouse <i>Perognathus longimembris pacificus</i>	FE, CSC, MHCP, NE	Open coastal sage scrub; fine, alluvial sands near ocean.
