PROJECT STATUS

A Citizen Participation Program (CPP) Meeting was held in February of 2022. Planning Commission approved the Major Use Permit 9/7/23, and the permit application for the California Coastal Commission is being prepared by Staff.

Construction of this project is expected to occur in Spring 2024.

PROJECT BUDGET

The project design and construction are estimated to cost \$842,000 and is largely state funded through the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). The City is providing local funds of approximately 10% of the total project cost for design and construction.

PROJECT LOCATION

Along S Coast HWY 101 in front of Cardiff State Beach.

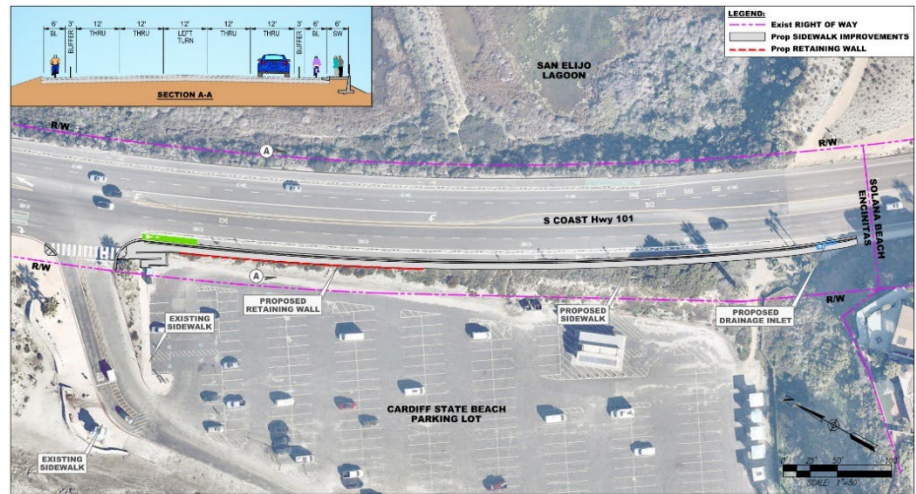

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S. Coast Highway 101 Sidewalk Improvements to Solana Beach (CS22D)



ABOUT THE PROJECT

The S. Coast Highway 101 Sidewalk Improvements to Solana Beach (CS22D) will construct a sidewalk on the west side of South Coast Highway 101 between the South Cardiff State Beach Parking Lot Entrance and the city limits with Solana Beach. Currently, a pedestrian facility does not exist along this segment. Pedestrians utilize the existing bike lane for travel.

The project scope involves installing approximately 675 linear feet of curb and sidewalk, construction of retaining walls along portions of the sidewalk, new curb ramps and crosswalk striping.

The project will maintain the current separated bike lane with the installation of the new sidewalk. The project is in alignment with the City's Active Transportation Plan.

Construction is estimated to take approximately 3-4 months. Cardiff State Beach will remain open and accessible during construction.
