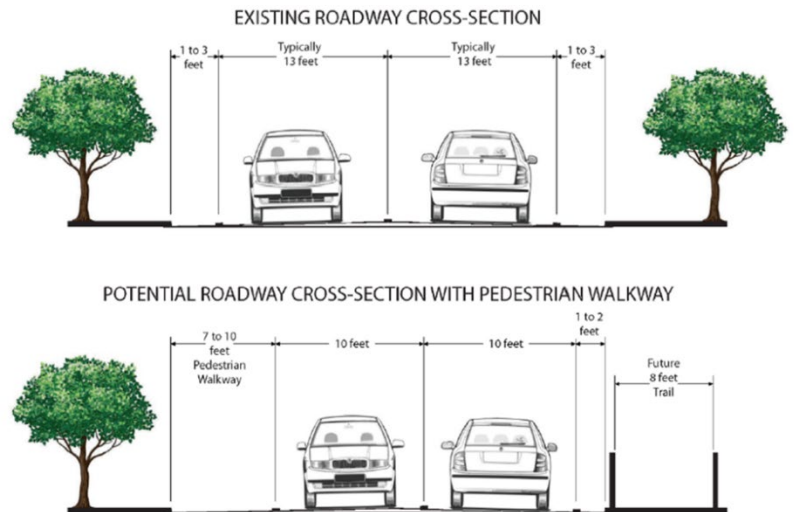

Rancho Santa Fe Road Safety and Mobility Enhancements

ABOUT THE PROJECT

In December 2019 the City funded a corridor analysis of Rancho Santa Fe Road, between Avenida La Posta/Calle Acervo and Encinitas Boulevard to enhance mobility, improve travel time and minimize travel delays along the corridor.

With the Santa Fe Road Task Force, current traffic conditions were analyzed to develop options to improve traffic. Residents preferred to improve traffic conditions by modifying intersection control methods. Considering the high volume of traffic on Rancho Santa Fe Rd. as well as the high level of pedestrian activity along the corridor, staff identified the need for improving the facilities along this corridor.

A comprehensive study was conducted by the City's consultant, STC Traffic, Inc., to evaluate the feasibility of implementing various improvements including roundabouts, traffic signals, striping modifications and raised crosswalks. Various traffic control alternatives were presented to the City Council in 2021. Interim striping improvements and raised crosswalks are to be implemented.

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
