# THE PROJECT

El Camino Real is a busy commercial corridor that serves as a major thoroughfare for the City of Encinitas. The General Plan envisions a more vibrant, walkable mixture of land uses. In order to achieve this vision, the City has initiated the preparation of the El Camino Real Specific Plan. The Specific Plan Project will include:

- An opportunities and constraints analysis, including market conditions and demands, multi-modal access & connectivity, and parking analyses.
- A Land Use Plan that provides a regulatory framework for future development along the El Camino Real corridor.
- Development standards to implement the reimagined vision for the corridor.
- An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
- Community engagement opportunities during the entire planning process.

## WHY?

Market conditions and community needs have changed since the Project Area was first developed, making the area prime for revitalization and new investment. The development of a specific plan for the El Camino Real Corridor will help to provide the necessary development standards in order to further implement a blueprint for the community.



The El Camino Real Specific Plan has the ability to transform the corridor to be a more inviting, walkable, and vibrant community with housing options in proximity to favorable destinations.



# **PROJECT GOALS**

#### Goals of the project include:

- A reimagined vision for the revitalization of the El Camino Real corridor.
- Providing critically-needed housing options to infuse greater activity in the corridor and serve the community's housing needs.
- Compliance with the 2021–2029 Housing Element goals and programs.
- Improved transit, bicycle, and pedestrian connections.
- Enhanced green space through improvement of creek connections, street trees, and other amenities.

### COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

The City will be offering a diverse range of opportunities for the community to participate and provide valuable input, including:

- Public Workshops: Three will be held throughout the Project timeline
