

## UTILITY PERMIT PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY FEES & INFORMATION

A Public Right-of-Way Utility permit is required when public right-of-way work will occur on existing or proposed utilities.

Approved permits are valid for one year and are not transferable to another location.

All fees associated with this permit are non-refundable.

Fees:

Application Fee: \$423 (200 linear feet or less)

6.7% of ACE (more than 200 linear feet)

Business Registration Must have a current business registration with the City. Business

Registration is a separate process and can be applied for

concurrently with this permit.

## **Documentation Required:**

- Certificate Insurance Must have general liability coverage, minimum \$1 million for each occurrence and aggregate for combined bodily injury and property damage. The policy number, effective date, and expiration date must be provided. Work must be completed prior to the expiration date of the policy.
- Form Stormwater Intake Form & Standard SWQMP Required for every project to categorize and document the project's status as it relates to local and state stormwater quality requirements.
- Plans Proposed Work in Public Right-of-Way Plans showing proposed work to be done in public right-of-way.
- Standard Conditions Right-of-Way Construction Acknowledgement of conditions which must be adhered to when accessing or performing work in a Public Right-of-Way.
