







# **Project Purpose & Goals**

- Create conceptual designs for potential rail crossing projects, which will then be brought forward as funding becomes available and future grants are applied for.
- Build upon the recommendations of the recently completed Rail Corridor Vision Study and Coastal Mobility & Livability Study
- Prioritize 20 potential "crossing" and "connector" projects
- Develop conceptual plans for each project
- Create an implementation strategy to secure funding and regulatory approvals

### **Potential Projects**

8 "Crossings" are rail overpasses or underpasses that help people navigate across the tracks

12 "Connectors" are other improvements—such as sidewalks, crosswalks, and bike lanes—that connect the crossings to the larger transportation network






# **Community Survey**

- May-June 2019
- Distributed via postal mail, e-mail & social media
- Respondents:
  - 678 residents
  - 16 businesses
- Top priorities for crossings:
  - Improve safety
  - Reduce traffic/pollution

- Top locations for <u>new</u> crossings:
  - 1. Grandview St/Hillcrest Dr
  - 2. Sanford St/Jupiter St
  - 3. Marcheta St/Orpheus Av
- Top locations for <u>upgrades</u> to existing crossings:
  - 1. Leucadia Blvd
  - 2. La Costa Ave

*H St/I St and Norfolk Dr/Dublin Dr are highly constrained and likely infeasible
