Reduce greenhouse gas emissions in Encinitas by 44% by 2030

ABOUT THE PROJECT

Excessive burning of fossil fuels like gasoline and natural gas release large amounts greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions into the atmosphere. This causes increased heating of Earth's atmosphere which leads to disruptions in the global climate. Climate change can cause extreme weather events such as prolonged droughts and rising sea levels. It can also exacerbate other environmental issues such as ocean acidification and habitat degradation, in addition to impacting human health.

The City established this ongoing project to help reduce GHG emissions and alleviate climate change impacts. In its most recent Climate Action Plan, the City committed to reducing GHG emissions by 13% by 2020 and 44% by 2030. The actions, supporting measures, and adaptation strategies outlined in the CAP will be implemented by the City to meet the reduction targets and goals stated in the CAP. Various CAP projects and programs include building ordinances, bike and pedestrian facilities, public education and outreach, and others. This project also includes conducting annual reports and maintaining an online Climate Dashboard to demonstrate progress, in addition to completing 5-year updates to the CAP.

This project aligns with the City's environmental vision and the strategy to promote green initiatives and protect natural resources within the Encinitas Strategic Plan.
