Housing & Equity

Housing & Equity means providing a diversity of housing, aiming to have a roof over everyone's head, engaging underrepresented populations, and ensuring the provision of support services.

<u>Goals</u>

- 1) In addition to the Housing Element requirements, ensure availability of 50 City-produced affordable housing units in 5 years.
- 2) Implement 100% of the recommended actions within the Homelessness Action Plan in 5 years.
- 3) Implement and/or address 100% of the goals identified in the Housing Element in 5 years.

- Help for the people living or becoming unsheltered
- Implement the Homeless Action Plan
- Regional/state issues
- Housing for all income levels
- Identify & involve underrepresented populations
- Examine policies and procedures around equity for staff, Boards, and Commissions

Effective Resident Services

Effective Resident Services means services are provided timely, courteously, fairly, and predictably.

<u>Goals</u>

- 1) Improve Development Services' overall customer service rating from "poor" to "excellent" in 3 years.
- 2) Develop long-term funding strategies to meet 100% of identified Capital needs within 5 years.
