

## **PROJECT STATUS**

Signal poles and mast arms for the project are currently on order (average lead time is 7-8 months). Construction is expected to start in late Fall 2023 once the Contractor obtains all traffic signal equipment.

## **PROJECT BUDGET**

The construction contract for this project was awarded to Blue Pacific Engineering in the amount not to exceed \$657,260. The project is largely funded through a HSIP grant using federal funds.

# Left Turn Traffic Signal Improvements Project (CS02G) Creating a Safer Transportation Network



# ABOUT THE PROJECT

In 2017, a Cycle 8 HSIP (Highway Safety Improvement Program) grant administered by Caltrans was awarded to the City to modify and improve four traffic signals within the City by adding protected left turn phasing to the signalized intersections. The improvements include the installation of new traffic signal poles, mast arms, equipment, and installation of ADA compliant pedestrian ramps at four signalized intersections.

The four traffic signal locations are the intersections of:

- 1) Encinitas Boulevard/Vulcan Avenue
- 2) Leucadia Boulevard/Vulcan Avenue
- 3) Santa Fe Drive/Scripps Hospital Driveway
- 4) Leucadia Boulevard/Quail Gardens Drive

In May 2022, the City received authorization from Caltrans to start the construction phase of the project. On May 25, 2022 City Council approved the plans and specifications for the project and authorized advertisement. Subsequently, a construction contract was awarded in October 2022 and a Notice to Proceed was issued in February 2023.

The improvements will provide enhanced pedestrian and cyclist safety, mobility, and accessibility.
