- · Bullying or acts of aggression or violence.
- · Possession or use of illegal substances, tobacco, or alcohol.
- Possession of weapons any object that may cause harm to another or place another person in fear of his/her safety, may
 be considered a weapon.

Discipline Policy

Depending on the seriousness of the violation of the Code of Conduct, disciplinary action will be progressive and may begin at any of the following steps:

- · Verbal counseling (warning) from Instructor and/or Staff.
- · Written/Joint counseling from Manager.
- · Suspension.
- · Expulsion.

Aside from verbal counseling, disciplinary action will be fully documented, and will be informed of all actions taken. At any time during the process the participant may request a meeting with Encinitas staff.
