ENCINITAS VALVE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

WHAT IS IT?

The Valve Replacement Project replaces water valves at 22 intersections in Old Encinitas from East D Street south to Santa Fe Drive. This critical infrastructure requires updating to preserve public health and safety and limit the number of service disruptions.

HOW WILL IT IMPACT ME?

All residents will be notified twice, once at least 48 hours in advance, of any scheduled water interruptions. This notification will be in the form of a door hanger. The District has phased the project to limit customer disruptions.

During construction, residents may be out of water for over 8 hours. The time may be extended beyond the planned window if there are unforeseen circumstances.

Please contact the District if you have any special needs that require uninterrupted water service; i.e. daycare facility, specific medical requirements, etc.

WHAT IS A VALVE?

Valves are one of the most important devices available in operating a water distribution system. They can shut off, turn on, and regulate the flow of water, reduce pressures, provide air release and vacuum relief, blow off or drain water from parts of the system, and prevent backflow.
