The Project replaces aging water valves at 22 intersections in Old Encinitas from East D Street south to Santa Fe Drive. Valves are one of the most important devices available in operating a water system. This critical infrastructure requires updating and can help limit the size of service disruptions and preserve public health and safety.
