This project proposes a 495 SF second story addition to provide a master bedroom suite and a 185 SF outside master suite at rear of house. This property is owned by The Norris Family is zoned R-11. The project requires the following:

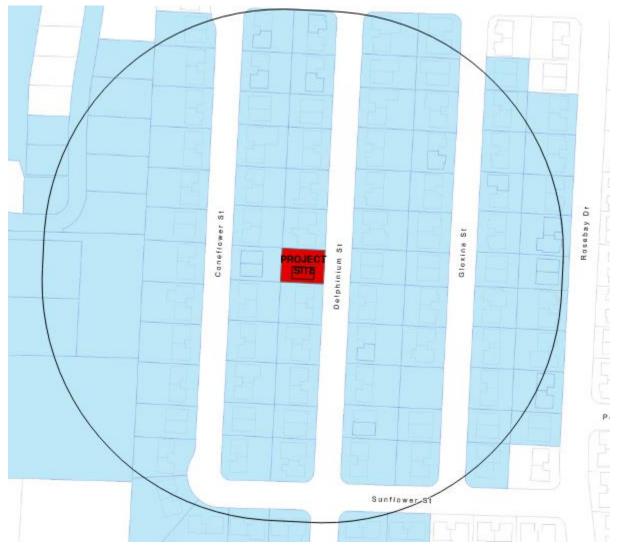
- 1. A Design Review Permit is required because there is an existing duplex on site, project sites that have more than requires Design Review.
- 2. A Coastal Development Permit is required because of the proposed second story addition to a duplex that requires design review.

Additional project details: the site currently has an existing single story duplex residence, the proposed project would build a second story master suite above the rear portion of the existing home, the proposed second story is 495 SF and there is a deck of 185 SF proposed at the rear of the master suite, the style of the existing home will be maintained and the stucco finish of the first story will remain and the second story will use lap siding with white trim. The roof slope will match that of the existing house and run east to west. The site is surrounded by residential duplexes on all sides.
