






## Site History

- 1975: The County of San Diego approves a new Cardiff Sea Village subdivision
- Subdivision approval includes a requirement to only allow Emergency Access between Crest/Wales and that a barrier be installed "to prohibit any thru traffic".







## Site History - Continued

- 2/26 Lake Drive closed, emergency detour established
- 5/17 Public Hearing
- 7/12 Lake Drive re-opened, detour closed
- 7/31 1<sup>st</sup> Public Community Meeting Held








### Site History - Continued

- At the 5/17 Public Hearing, Council directed staff to close the junction after Lake Drive was re-opened, and to install an electric gate for emergency ingress/egress only, with considerations for aesthetics in the design.
- Control of the gate will be kept by the Encinitas Fire Department and the Sheriff's Office.
- A funding appropriation of \$100,000 was made for the design and construction of the project.




## 75% Design - Site Configuration



### **Key Details**

- Gate: 4 ft tall arch, single picket
- Post Style: 4"x4" black posts with caps
- Curb to Striping (Bike Access): 4.5 ft
- Hatched Striping Area: 30'x20'
- Painted Curb with "NO PARKING FIRE LANE" lettering

### Considerations Raised at the Last Community Meeting

#### Stormwater & Drainage

• The existing drainage system has been investigated and will not be impacted by the proposed project. Existing drainage patterns will not be altered.

#### Intersection of Wales Drive and Via Tiempo

 A traffic study will be conducted to evaluate if intersection controls are warranted at Via Tiempo and Wales Drive. This action is independent of the proposed project.

#### Vegetation

 Planters, irrigation, and maintenance were not included in the funding for the proposed project. The City would be happy to review a ROW encroachment permit if residents would like to place planters and provide maintenance (so long as the improvements don't impact the ingress/egress area)
