CITY OF ENCINITAS PUBLIC NOTICE OF ORDINANCE INTRODUCTION ORDINANCE NO. 2023-07

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Encinitas has introduced Ordinance No. 2023-07 "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Encinitas, California, adding Chapter 9.85 "Shopping Carts" to the Encinitas Municipal Code to Require Containment of Shopping Carts on Business Premises and Making it Unlawful to Remove a Shopping Cart Therefrom." Proposed Ordinance No. 2023-07 establishes two enforceable components:

- It is unlawful to remove a marked shopping cart from a premises or to be in possession of a marked shopping cart.
- It is unlawful for a shopping cart owner (as defined in the ordinance) to allow a shopping cart to be abandoned or remain unattended.

In addition, the proposed ordinance language builds out extended shopping cart owner responsibility in several ways, including provisions requiring the following:

- Shopping cart ownership identification on all carts.
- Installation of shopping cart removal warning signs.
- Use of physical containment measures OR a shopping cart retrieval service.
- After hours shopping cart security.
- Submittal of a shopping cart containment plan to the City of Encinitas.
