### AMERICANS FOR THE ARTS AEP6 BACKGROUND

AEP6 is the sixth economic impact study of the nonprofit arts and culture industry in the U.S. by Americans for the Arts.

Encinitas is among 373 participating study regions nationwide.



## AMERICANS FOR THE ARTS AEP6 SURVEY COLLECTION

#### **Timeline**

Events happened in Encinitas May 1, 2022-June 30, 2023

#### **Audience Data**

A minimum of 400 audience surveys were required, 477 were collected.


#### **Diversity**

## AEP6 RESULTS **ECONOMIC IMPACT**

The arts and culture sector in Encinitas generated nearly \$28 million in total economic activity.





# AEP6 RESULTS NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

Nonprofit arts and culture organizations are businesses.

They employ people locally, purchase goods and services from within the community, and attract tourists to their regions.

They stay longer and spend more to seek out authentic cultural experiences.

# AEP6 RESULTS SOCIAL IMPACT

The survey confirmed a rich agreement about the social and economic benefits that arts and culture provide the community.

- 63% understand cultures
- 70% image and identity
- 72% shared experiences
- 79% economy and local jobs
- **86%** quality of life and livability
