

BIKE AND E-BIKE RESOURCES

If you ride, or are considering riding an e-bike in and around Encinitas, please take the time to learn what's allowed, what the applicable laws are and follow guidelines and recommendations for riding safely.

Visit www.EncinitasCA.Gov/Ebikes to find information and resources for safe cycling.

City Cycling Bike/E-Bike Safety & Skills Class (ages 10 and up*)

Under the direction of a trained bike instructor, you will learn the rules of the road and practice essential bike riding skills. Learn where to ride, best practices, emergency maneuvers, and legal rights and responsibilities.

The three-hour class is broken up into three parts: lecture, skills drills, and a guided road ride to put your new skills into action! Class content applies to both regular and e-bikes. Make sure your bike is in good working order and ready to ride. Some cycling experience is required as this is not a "learn-to-ride" class.

Encinitas residents will receive a refund of registration amount after completion of the course (\$2.70 ActiveNet system processing fee is non-refundable). *If under 16, parent registration and participation is strongly encouraged. For participants 12 and under, parent registration and participation required. For info and to register, visit www.EncinitasCA.gov/Ebikes.





PROGRAM TRANSFER POLICY:

Transfers may be requested up to five (5) calendar days before the start of the program by emailing prca@encinitasca.gov and will incur a \$10 transfer fee if the transfer is to a program of equal or lesser value. Transfers to a program of greater value will include the transfer fee, program fee difference, and an additional processing fee. Transfer requests by phone or by leaving a message will not be considered. Transfer requests made less than five (5) calendar days before the start of the class must be submitted by email to prca@encinitasca.gov. Transfer requests made less than five (5) days are date stamped and reviewed by management.
